Owen and Moley Ó Súilleabháin are two brothers in their late 20s from the west coast of Ireland. They have been singing and performing spiritual song all their lives. Their mother, Nóirín Ní Riain, is considered a national treasure in Ireland and is one of Ireland's most prolific spiritual singers. In the 80s she recorded a trilogy of seminal recordings of Gregorian Chant with the monks of Glenstal Abbey in Co. Limerick.

Owen and Moley went on to boarding school at the Benedictine Abbey and sang with the monks there at their liturgies for six years. After that they began recording and performing with the mother Noirin. They recorded two albums with her - Biscantorat, also featuring Irish singer Sinead O Connor, and Celtic Joy. Both of these recordings feature Gregorian Chant, Early Music and sacred songs in the Irish Language.

They have performed all over the world and have been featured regularly on Irish national TV and radio. Most recently they performed with their mother for the Dalai Lama's visit to Ireland earlier this year.

Owen and Moley also started their own band, size2shoes, that brings together a mix of acoustic and inspirational pop music and rap. They will be releasing their own second album very soon.
