Offertory revenue reflects a modest increase from the prior year, which included annual offertory appeal with Christmas collection increase consistent with prior years. Thank you for your continued support of our Parish.

Faith formation summer program income receipt was deferred into July 2025 in the current fiscal year period.

Gifts/bequests - FYE 2024 reflected a significant increase due to a one time gift from a generous parishioner. Netting this out from annual comparison FYE 2025 reflects a modest increase year over year. The Parish has started to budget some of this money for building repairs/improvements. The Archdiocese will be applying an 18% assessment (\$170K) from this gift in the 2025-26 fiscal period.

School rental income has increased parish revenues in the interim. However, the lease expires in 2026 and is subject to renewal.

The Parish is currently benefitting from participation in the Archdiocese investment program, increasing interest income in interim.

Parish annual operating costs continue to rise with material increases in the current FY period related to Religious Education program expenses, higher insurance costs, higher gas & electric costs, and telephone contract replacement.
